About the Speaker:

Mr. CHHIENG Pich started to work for the Government since early 1993 as a Private Secretary to the Vice Minister, Ministry of Economy and Finance. He then moved to the Ministry of Commerce in 1994, working as a Private Secretary to the Minister. He was promoted in 1997 as Deputy Director, Foreign Trade Department, Ministry of Commerce and was responsible in overseeing the Foreign Trade Department (FTD) and to facilitate all commercial activities between Cambodia and the outside world, which includes the study and the formation of bilateral trade agreements and Memorandum of Understandings.

In April 1999, he was assigned to work in Washington DC as a Commercial Counsellor and spent six years in the US, promoting trade and investment between two countries. He returned home in May 2005 and then joined the Bilateral Department as a Deputy Director, Ministry of Commerce in July 2005. He has been assigned once again to work in Singapore as a Commercial Counsellor since July 2008.
